

Engage Worship Image Licence

Thanks for purchasing this pack of images. It means a lot that you thought they might be useful.

Just a few things about the legal side of all this... They're pretty standard, based on how any major stock image site would licence the images.

So...

1) All of the included images are © 2016 Kieran Metcalfe / Engage Worship.

2) The purchase of these images gives you a licence which is **non-exclusive** (as in other people can buy them too) and **royalty-free** (you don't have to pay anything else in the future regarding using them), and which allows you to use them in the following ways:

- **You can project them** either on their own or as part of a PowerPoint (or similar) presentation
- **You can include them in another media project** - printed materials, videos, album & book covers etc (up to 50,000 copies).
- **You can use them on your blog site.** If you're feeling generous a credit ("EngageWorship.org | Kieran Metcalfe") and / or a link back to engageworship.org or my flickr page (flickr.com/kieranmetcalfe) would be great, but that's not essential.
- **You can modify them** - don't like the colour? Want to add your own creative flair? That's all good. If you're proud of what you've done with them, and you'd like to show it off, drop me an email (details at the bottom) I'd love to see how these are being used!

3) However, the licence does have a few restrictions:

- **You may not sell any of the images** on to someone else - even if you've altered them. If any of the original image is visible, then that's not permitted without prior permission.
- **You may not post the images on the internet**, unless they're part of an advert for an event etc, or illustrating a blog post. So you CAN use them in online publicity for your service but you CAN'T put them on a file-sharing site where other people could get hold of them for free etc, or share them around using Dropbox / iCloud / OneDrive / Google Drive or anything like that. Don't put them on Facebook or your Flickr/Instagram/Tumblr account just for it's own sake.
- **You may not use the unaltered image on something you're selling** - i.e. you can't just put the image on a mug or t-shirt and sell them. However, as above if you've altered the image, or made it into an album cover, book cover etc where there's a substantial amount of extra stuff included that is nothing to do with the image, you're ok to use it as long as you're not producing more than 50,000 copies. If you are, don't give up - just drop me a line to discuss it first.
- As the licence is granted solely to you, **you may not give the images to someone else for them to use**, unless it's in direct connection with the organisation you bought them for - i.e., if you bought them for your church, you're fine to give them to the media team for use in services at your church, but you're not permitted to give them to a separate church for them to use. Instead, please point them to EngageWorship.org and ask them to buy their own copy. Again this applies even if you've edited them.
- And, fairly obviously, **you may not claim that images are your own work, or that you own the copyright for them** - because they're not, and you don't :)
